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(4.323%), and Steven Golsen, an executive officer of a subsidiary of the Issuer (4.323%), and his daughter, Linda Rappaport (4.323%). Jack E. Golsen has sole voting and dispositive power over the Issuer securities held by GFLLC and shares voting and dispositive power over the Issuer securities held by SBL (see footnote 2). The reporting person reports beneficial ownership of all securities held by GFLLC and SBL due to his shared voting and dispositive power over the securities beneficially owned by GFLLC and SBL, but disclaims beneficial ownership of such securities, except to the extent of his respective pecuniary interest therein.

SBL, LLC ("SBL") is owned by GFLLC (49%), Barry Golsen (17%), Steven Golsen (17%), and Linda Rappaport (17%). Golsen Petroleum Corporation ("GPC") is a wholly owned subsidiary of SBL. The amount shown in Table I includes 1,401,866 shares of common stock owned directly by SBL and 283,955 shares of common stock owned directly by GPC; 200,000 of these shares have been

- (2) pledged as collateral. The amount shown in Table II includes 12,000 shares of the Issuer's Series B Preferred owned directly by SBL and 4,000 shares of the Issuer's Series B Preferred owned directly by GPC. Voting and dispositive power over the securities held by SBL and GPC is shared by Jack E. Golsen, who is the chief executive officer and chairman of the board of the Issuer, and Barry Golsen, a director and the president of the Issuer.

- (3) These shares of common stock are owned of record by a trust, of which Jack E. Golsen is trustee.

These shares are held by separate trusts established for the benefit of the children, grandchildren, and a great-grandchild (the "Trusts") of the reporting person, of which Jack E. Golsen is the settlor and sole trustee. The amount shown is the aggregate number of shares held in the Trusts. No single Trust has more than one beneficiary. As the sole trustee, Jack E. Golsen possesses sole voting and dispositive power over the Issuer securities held in the Trusts, but holds no pecuniary interest in the securities held by the Trusts.

- (4) The Issuer's Series "D" 6% Cumulative, Convertible Class C Preferred Stock is convertible at the option of the holder into the Issuer's common stock at the rate of four shares of Preferred "D" for one share of common stock. Each share is convertible as long as such is outstanding.
- (5) Each share of the Issuer's Series "B" 12% Cumulative Preferred Stock is convertible, at the option of the holder into 33.3333 shares of the Issuer's common stock. Each share is convertible as long as such is outstanding.

- (6) On June 9, 2014, SBL sold a total of 29,656 shares of the Issuer's common stock, pursuant to a previously adopted 10b5-1 sales plan, at the weighted average price per share of \$40.03, which is based on multiple prices ranging from \$40.00 to \$40.15. The reporting person undertakes to provide to the Issuer, any security holder of the Issuer, or the staff of the Securities and Exchange Commission, upon request, full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price within the range.
