#### Item 1.01. Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement

On August 22, 2005, the Compensation Committee of the Board of Directors of ProQuest Company (the Company) approved a discretionary bonus of \$450,000 to be paid to Andrew Wyszkowski, President of ProQuest Business Solutions.
