Medtronic and Covidien Provide Update on Expected Close Date of Acquisition

On October 30, Medtronic and Covidien confirmed that both companies expect the acquisition to close in early calendar year 2015. This is based on, among other things, the expected timing required to finalize the joint proxy statement/prospectus and obtain necessary regulatory and shareholder approvals, and thereafter obtain approval of the Irish High Court. This is consistent with what was first communicated in June, when leaders of both companies said they expected the transaction to close in the fourth calendar quarter of 2014 or early in 2015.
