- 15,000 non-qualified stock options (the "Stock Options") convertible solely into common shares were granted to Julian C. Baker. The Stock Options have a strike price of \$60.85 and vest on the first anniversary of the grant date or, if earlier, the date of the next regular annual meeting of the Issuer stockholders or upon a change in control of the Issuer (as defined in the Issuer's Amended and Restated 2010 Stock Incentive Plan). Julian C. Baker serves on the Board as a representative of the Funds. Pursuant to the policies of the Adviser, Julian C. Baker does not have any right to any of the Issuer's securities issued as part of his service on the Board and the Funds are entitled to receive all the pecuniary interest in the securities issued.
- The Funds each own an indirect proportionate pecuniary interest in the Stock Options. Solely as a result of Felix J. Baker's and Julian C.
