- (6) On April 10, 2006, the common stock of The Manitowoc Company, Inc. split 2-for-1, resulting in the reporting person's daughter owning an additional 150 shares.
- (8) On April 10, 2006, the common stock of The Manitowoc Company, Inc. split 2-for-1. This balance reflects that split.
- (2) Includes amount and price of shares acquired in exempt transactions pursuant to a Shareholder Dividend Reinvestment Plan.
- (3) Average price of shares sold, with the sale ranging from \$53.00 to \$53.20.

- (7) On April 10, 2006, the common stock of The Manitowoc Company, Inc. split 2-for-1. This number consists of shares held under the Company's 401(k) plan (The Manitowoc Company, Inc. RSVP Profit Sharing Plan), including 39.5394 shares (split adjusted) acquired in transactions occurring between 12/31/04 and 12/31/05, which are exempt from Section 16(b) pursuant to Rule 16b-3 and exempt from reporting pursuant to Rule 16a-3(f)(1)(i)(B). The information in this report is based on a plan statement dated as of 12/31/05 and previously reported as 4,275.550 shares (including 19.7697 shares acquired in transactions occurring between 12/31/04 and 12/31/05), but was adjusted to reflect the stock split on April 10, 2006. From time to time, the plan administrator collects maintenance fees related to the RSVP Plan, which may result in the number of shares held by a participant in the RSVP Plan declining by a marginal amount.
- (5) Average price of shares sold, with the sale ranging from \$54.00 to \$54.08.
