Item 2.05 Costs Associated with Exit or Disposal Activities.

As previously disclosed in our Form 8-K filed on May 28, 2009, Jamba, Inc. (the Company) approved a plan to rebrand up to 150 company-owned stores, primarily outside of California. At the time of filing, the Company was unable to determine whether any charges would be incurred or in good faith make a determination of an estimate or range of estimates required by paragraphs (b), (c) and (d) of Item 2.05 of Form 8-K with respect to the costs and charges that may be incurred related to its rebranding efforts. This amendment updates the disclosure in Item 2.05 of our previously-filed Form 8-K filed on May 28, 2009.

To date, the Company has rebranded 102 stores for which the Company incurred aggregate impairment charges of \$5.5 million. The Company does not expect to incur additional charges for the rebranding of the balance of its stores identified for rebranding.

Forward-Looking Statement. This Current report on Form 8-K contains forward-looking statements relating to the rebranding of Company-operated stores, including statements regarding whether charges are expected to be incurred with respect to its remaining rebranding efforts. These forward-looking statements, as well as the underlying estimates and assumptions relating to such statements, are based on currently available operating, financial and competitive information and are subject to a number of significant risks and uncertainties. Actual future results may differ materially depending on a variety of factors including, but not limited to, risks related to achieving expected costs savings, income tax and other benefits associated with the store rebranding efforts in the anticipated time frame, if at all, and the risks detailed in the Company's filings with the Securities and Exchange Commission, including the Risk Factors section of the Company's Annual Report on Form 10-K for the fiscal year ended December 29, 2009. The Company assumes no obligation to update any of these forward-looking statements.
